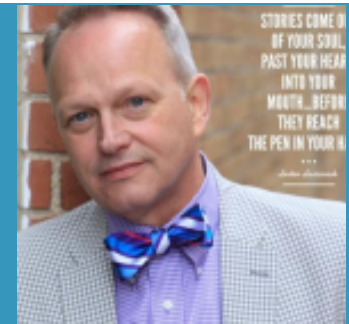

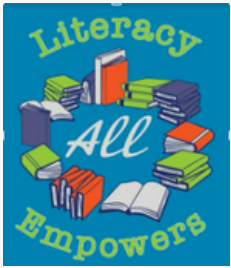
PSLA Theory to Practice Strand Literacy Leaders Committee Catherine Compton-Lilly
