#### **SESSION OPTIONS**

- **Pre-Conference Sessions**

- **Concurrent Sessions**

Proposals from these sessions are submitted as 1 or 1.5 hour presentations on **Friday, February 25th** or **Saturday, February 26th**. These sessions provide participants with hands-on experiences and/or expositions of relevant strategies and literacy topics related to the conference theme. In order to be considered as a conference presenter, one must be a member in good standing of their local council.

#### **CRITERIA**

Relevance of the topic and the quality and clarity of the proposal’s objectives, content, organization, and methods of presentation will be considered in the selection process, as well as the presenter(s) PSLA membership status.

#### **DEADLINE**

All proposals must be submitted using <https://forms.gle/HEw5HX2U2xDqhxMKA> no later than **September 30, 2021**. All items should be completed. The PSLA program committee will notify the person submitting the proposal in early **November 2021** of those proposals accepted. Paper copies or emailed proposals will not be accepted.
